
DUTIES

- Develop and execute training programs on mapping and staking systems.
- Perform quality control of digital maps and help in creating standards and auditing.
- Create and maintain large format maps based on organizational requirements.
- Act as a resource for GIS mapping issues, questions, and troubleshooting in collaborate with the GIS team & System Operation Team.
- Act as support for projects, when required.
- Other related tasks, as required.
